



Interested in Engaging Youth In Service? Start a YVC program!

Founded in 1987, the Youth Volunteer Corps has grown to include affiliates in 55 communities across the U.S. and Canada. Annually, YVC engages 15,000 11-18 year olds in adult supervised, youth-led educational service projects in partnership with other non-profit agencies that strengthen communities, celebrate diversity and teach youth about the importance of being active members of their communities through service.

What do I need to do to get started?

- Identify a sponsoring agency (must have a 501(c)3 designation) - current sponsors include Boys & Girls Club, CampFire, HandsOn/Volunteer Centers, United Way, Parks & Recreation & YMCA
- Find adequate funding/staff to run a program—can be part time, must be able to run a year-round program (school year & summer)
- Sign an affiliation agreement with YVC and pay \$500 fee



What does the affiliation fee include?

The affiliation fee includes over \$3,500 in marketing, training and technology benefits annually as well as access to YVC AmeriCorps members, pass through funding and access to a highly skilled network of programs.
